The accommodation is in modern flats comprising of 5 en-suite single bedrooms per flat.



TOURNAMENT DETAILS AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TEAM APPLICATIONS

Teams who are in membership of their Local and National Associations are invited to make application to participate in the Scotland Cup Tournaments.

LOCAL TEAMS (11 A-Side)

Initially two teams from the local area in each 11 a-side age group shall be invited to participate by the Tournament Committee.

Teams from the local area where the Scotland Cup Tournaments are staged can make application to participate by returning the Application Form. However, we cannot guarantee a place in the tournament until the numbers of teams from out with the local area are finalised in each age group. Should additional teams be required in any age group local teams will be invited to participate by the Tournament Committee.

TEAM ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS / RULES / TOURNAMENT FIXTURES

When your team application is approved by the Tournament Committee a Team Entry confirmation will be emailed to you together with a copy of the relevant tournament rules. At this point you MUST make application to your Local and National Association for permission to participate in the Scotland Cup. The tournament fixtures will be emailed to all the participating teams 7-10 days prior to the tournament kicking off. The fixtures will also be posted on the Scotland Cup website, and the Scotland Cup App will also go live displaying all tournament fixtures and relevant information.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

All teams will be required to complete a Player Registration Form, which includes the full name and date of birth of each player to be registered for the Scotland Cup Tournament. The forms will be signed by your club secretary or Coach to confirm that all details are correct. The Scotland Cup committee will retain a copy of this form in the event that it should be necessary to follow up a query about a player's age. Teams are also required to bring either league registration documents or appropriate identification (copy of passport or birth certificate) for all players to the event as proof of age.

MEDALS & AWARDS

All players will receive a quality medal as a memento of Scotland Cup 2022. 11 a-side winners from Age 13's will receive either the Scotland Cup or Scotland Plate.

PLEASE NOTE: In accordance with the Scotlish Youth Football Association rules and Player Pathway, all age sections at the small sided age groups will be played on a festival basis, results will NOT be recorded or displayed. All players will receive a quality Scotland Cup participation medal.

SPIRIT OF FRIENDSHIP / EXCHANGE OF PENNANTS

The Scotland Cup tournaments are proud to support and promote, Sportsmanship. Skill, Participation and Friendships, Respect to match officials and fellow players and SAY NO TO RACISM

Although not compulsory, it is customary for teams to exchange a pennant or small memento before each game, in keeping with the spirit of the Scotland Cup Tournaments.

PHOTOGRAPHS / VIDEO PRODUCTION

By registering your team(s), you are also agreeing that Scotland Cup Tournaments may, if appropriate, use any photographs, video and live broadcast taken by the event photographers, video production team at Scotland Cup Tournaments in 2022 of individual players or teams, for use on social media, website, marketing and advertising. If you would not like any of the afore mentioned of your players or teams to be used for this purpose for any reason, you must notify Scotland Cup Tournaments via email prior to the tournament taking place.

By registering your team(s), you are also agreeing that authorised accredited media outlets may, if appropriate, use any photographs, video and live broadcast taken by the event photographers or on site press / media photographers at Scotland Cup Tournaments 2022 of individual players or teams, to be published in print, online or for other forms of publication. If you would not like photography of your players or teams to be used for this purpose for any reason, you must notify Scotland Cup Tournaments via email prior to the tournament taking place.

CURTAILMENT / CANCELLATION

The Organising Committee cannot be held responsible for the curtailment or cancellation of the tournament due to adverse weather conditions (Act of God) or the decision of other teams to withdraw from the tournament.

We do not accept liability for any loss, damage or expense arising from a change or cancellation to the Scotland Cup tournaments which occurs due to unusual or unforeseeable circumstances beyond our control and or that of our suppliers. Such events would include but are not limited to, war, threat of war, riots, civil strife, pandemics, industrial disputes, terrorist activity, fire or adverse weather conditions, natural or nuclear disaster, decisions of Football Associations or similar events beyond our control.

BEHAVIOUR AND CONDUCT

It is a condition of participation in any Scotland Cup Tournament in 2022 that you agree to accept the authority and decisions of the Scotland Cup organising committee. It is the responsibility of the Group Leader and adults to ensure the behaviour of all members of your team is acceptable at all times at the accommodation and tournament venues. Clubs will be charged for any damages caused by members of their party. Misconduct while at the accommodation, or at the event itself, may also be reported to the appropriate Local and National Associations by Scotland Cup Tournaments, for further disciplinary action to be taken as deemed appropriate.
